Designed to be taken in sequence, the Cisco Discovery 1 & 2 courses are exam preparation courses to aid in obtaining foundational networking certifications. Cisco Discovery 1 will assist students in preparing to sit for the Cisco Certified Entry Networking Technician (CCENT) exam. The CCENT certification opens the doors to a career in networking and means you have what it takes to manage a small, enterprise branch network. The CCENT certification helps you stand out from the crowd in entry-level network positions. Prerequisites for Cisco Discovery include: Basic PC skills & an aptitude for technology plus A+ Certification or comparable experience

Cisco Discovery 2 will assist students in preparing to sit for the Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) certification. The CCNA certification is important for those pursuing networking careers and demonstrates basic competency in installation and support of medium-sized networks. Students will receive hands-on introduction to networking and internet technologies, in addition to NetLab online assignments. Course topics include LAN and WAN design, operating with multiple switches supporting VLANs, trunking, switch stacking, chassis aggregation and spanning tree protocols. This course will prepare students for the CCNA exam 200-105 ICND2. Prerequisite for Cisco Discovery 2: CCNDI or CCENT certification.
