



## 3-WHEEL COURSE

This is a basic, entry-level, learn-to-ride 3-wheel motorcycle training and education course. It provides the same fundamental skills as the MSF Basic Rider Course, but on a 3-wheel, 3-track motorcycle (not sidecars). Rider coaches who have been trained and certified by the MSF conduct the course, which consists of both classroom and hands-on instruction including classroom instruction, riding exercises and a knowledge and skill test. A completion card and DMV Skills Test License Waiver will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

### Requirements

You do not need to possess a driver's license or learner's permit to take the course. The course is physically demanding. You must be able to support a motorcycle while straddling it and have the ability to push it for short distances. 100 percent attendance is mandatory.

We provide the bikes and a limited number of DOT-approved helmets. Please bring your own helmet if you have one. In addition, you will be required to wear eye protection, a long-sleeved shirt or jacket, long pants (preferably denim), over-the-ankle footwear and full-fingered gloves.
