A. INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAX RETURN FILERS: *Please read to understand your two choices.*

- 1.) Using the **IRS Data Retrieval Tool** is the preferred way to verify income. If you have not already used the tool, go to studentaid.gov and select apply for aid, log in to the student's FAFSA. Select "Make FAFSA Corrections" and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. Follow the instructions to determine if the student and/or student's parent(s) can use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2020 tax information into the FAFSA.
- 2.) **If you are unable to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool or refuse to use the tool, you will need to supply a 2020 tax return transcript.** Go to www.irs.gov/Individuals/Get-Transcript to obtain and print your tax return transcript or call 1-800-908-9946. Make sure to request the "IRS tax return transcript" and not the "IRS tax account transcript."
