GUIDELINES:

- Eligibility: All current Rowan-Cabarrus Community College AFA in Visual Arts and AAS in Advertising and Graphic Design majors are eligible to submit artwork, as is any student currently enrolled in a curriculum Art Studio course
- Selection of Work: Students may submit up to five (5) pieces of artwork for consideration. All five (5) submissions may not be exhibited if space is not available and all submissions must meet presentation guidelines. The exhibition will be juried by a panel consisting of full-time faculty.
- Exhibition Dates: Selected artworks will be exhibited at the Rail Walk Artists Studios & Gallery. The exhibition will be open to view after the opening reception until November 5th.
- Fee: There is no entry fee.
- **Selling Artwork:** Participants may sell their work without a commission (sales will be made directly between student and buyer).
- **Submission Deadlines:** The Entry Form and Artwork(s) must be submitted no later than October 14th, 2022 at 12:00 p.m. All artwork(s) must be labeled. Entry forms may be emailed or delivered to campus with the artwork(s).
- Notification: Artists will be notified by email no later than October 18th, 2022.
- **Drop Off Location:** The Artwork(s) must be delivered to campus.

- Pick-up of Artwork not Selected: Works that are not selected for exhibition must be picked up by the student by October 28th, 2022.
- Collection of Artwork at the End of the Exhibition: Students are responsible for picking up their artwork from Building N107 on North Campus. Work not picked up by December 9th will become the property of Rowan-Cabarrus Community College.
- Liability: Participants submit work at their own risk. Artwork is not insured for damage or theft during drop-off, exhibition, or pick-up. Rowan-Cabarrus Community College is not responsible for lost, damaged, stolen, or compromised artwork.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

- All submitted work must have been created by the artist after January 1st, 2022.
- Submitted work cannot have been previously exhibited.
- All fine art mediums are encouraged (including performance, graphic design, video, etc.).
- There are no size requirements, however space is limited
- All 2D work must be prepared to hang with taut wire
 - Wire must be attached with screws; no glued or taped wires
 - No sawtooth hangers
 - All 2D work must be framed using simple, professional white or black frames. Frames must be wooden or metal or plastic.
 - Canvases may be unframed if they are gallery wrapped and the sides are painted. Canvases must not have exposed staples on the sides.
 Such canvases should be framed.
- 3D work must be able to sit solidly on the floor or on a stand
- 4D (video, performance, etc.) work should be submitted with an explanation of how it will be exhibited.
- All pieces must adhere to Rowan-Cabarrus Community College's Code of Conduct
- Work that does not meet the guidelines will not be included

IMPORTANT DATES:

- Friday, October 14th, 2022 at 12:00 pm: All entry forms must be submitted via email or delivered to campus with the submitted work.
- Friday, October 21st, 2022 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm: Opening Reception at Rail Walk. Free and open to the public! Plan to Attend!
- November 7th to November 11th, 2022: Students should arrange to pickup artwork from Building 107 on North Campus. Work not picked up by December 9th will become the property of Rowan-Cabarrus Community College.
