- CNA I is an admission requirement, therefore no points will be awarded
- CNA II is not an admission requirement; therefore, you can receive certificate points
- No points will be awarded for CPR as it is a clinical requirement

1 year experience as a CNA II = 3 points  
2 years' experience as a CNA II = 9 points

1 year experience as an LPN = 4 points  
2 years' experience as an LPN = 11 points

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***Qualifying scores will be determined annually by the nursing programs based on the national norm and program attrition data***

- Points will be awarded for applicants who meet the minimum score requirements for the KAPLAN Overall Score/ATI-TEAS Adjusted Individual Score and the Reading Score.
- If two or more students have the identical point count total, the reading score will be the deciding factor. If further validation is needed, the math score will be utilized.
- Total points will be rounded up for maximum total points awarded for admission test scores.
