Section A: Admission Test Scores

- The OTA program uses the ATI Test of Academic Skills (ATI TEAS®)
- The Occupational Therapy Assistant Program bases qualifying scores on the national norms and program attrition data. Rowan-Cabarrus Community College is continuously evaluating admissions procedures and reserves the right to make changes as necessary.
- Applicants who have met the ATI TEAS® qualifying scores will be further evaluated for admissions using the point system criteria.
- Student must meet or exceed the 60th Percentile Rank (PR) for Reading Comprehension and meet or exceed the 55th PR on Total Score to be eligible to move to the point system process.
- Points will be awarded for applicants who meet or exceed the minimum percentile rang (PR) requirements for ATI TEAS® Reading Comprehension and Total Score.
- If two or more students have the identical final point total, the Reading Comprehension qualifying score will be the deciding factor. If the Reading Comprehension score is tied, then the Total Score will be the next deciding factor.

*Students must meet or exceed the 60^{th} Percentile Rank for Reading and the 55^{th} Percentile Rank for the Total Score to be eligible to move to the competitive point system process
