- The PTA program bases qualifying scores on the national norms and program attrition data. Rowan-Cabarrus Community College is continuously evaluating admissions procedures and reserves the right to make changes, as necessary.
- Applicants who have met the ATI TEAS® qualifying scores will be further evaluated for admissions using the point system criteria.
- Points will be awarded for applicants who meet or exceed the minimum percentile rank (PR) requirements for ATI TEAS® Reading Comprehension and Total Score.
- If two or more students have the identical point count total, the Reading Comprehension qualifying score will be the deciding factor. If the Reading Comprehension score is tied, then the Total Score will be the next deciding factor.

*Students must meet or exceed the 50th percentile rank for both Reading and the Total Score to be eligible to move to the competitive point system process
