Radiography Graduation Requirements

To graduate from the Radiography program, the student must complete the following:

- 1. Meet the graduation policies as stated in the Rowan-Cabarrus Catalog and Student Handbook.
- 2. Meet competency standard/progression program requirements as outlined in the Radiography student handbook.
- 3. Complete all required coursework as stated in the Radiography Program of Study.
- 4. Graduation eligibility will be determined by the Registrar's office.
- 5. Refer to Applying for Graduation for current details.
- 6. Fulfill all financial obligations with Rowan-Cabarrus Community College.

Please note:

- The Radiography profession has a credentialing exam with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT).
- Any misdemeanor or felony conviction may affect the ability to participate in clinical rotations during the program and/or sit for the ARRT exam.
- Clinical coursework requires travel to locations throughout Rowan, Cabarrus, Mecklenburg, and Forsyth counties. Students must provide their own transportation.
- RAD 110 and RAD 141 are Hybrid Courses that require time on campus and online. (All other RAD coursework is completed in the classroom/lab or at the clinical setting).
