

# Radiography Graduation Requirements

To graduate from the Radiography program, the student must complete the following:

1. Meet the graduation policies as stated in the [Rowan-Cabarrus Catalog and Student Handbook](#).
2. Meet competency standard/progression program requirements as outlined in the Radiography student handbook.
3. Complete all required coursework as stated in the Radiography Program of Study.
4. Graduation eligibility will be determined by the Registrar's office.
5. Refer to [Applying for Graduation](#) for current details.
6. Fulfill all financial obligations with Rowan-Cabarrus Community College.

**Please note:**

- The Radiography profession has a credentialing exam with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT).
- Any misdemeanor or felony conviction may affect the ability to participate in clinical rotations during the program and/or sit for the ARRT exam.
- Clinical coursework requires travel to locations throughout Rowan, Cabarrus, Mecklenburg, and Forsyth counties. Students must provide their own transportation.
- RAD 110 and RAD 141 are Hybrid Courses that require time on campus and online. (All other RAD coursework is completed in the classroom/lab or at the clinical setting).
