Section A: Admission Test Scores – Kaplan or ATI-TEAS Scores

- The Radiography Program bases qualifying scores on the national norms and program attrition data. Rowan-Cabarrus Community College is continuously evaluating admissions procedures and reserves the right to make changes as necessary.
- Applicants who have met the admissions qualifying scores will be further evaluated for admissions using the point system criteria.
- Points will be awarded for applicants who meet the minimum qualifying scores for Reading Comprehension and Math. In addition, applicants may earn additional points for the Composite or Total Score.
- If two or more students have the identical point count total, the Reading Comprehension qualifying score will be the deciding factor. If further validation is needed, the score on the Math will be used.
- Total points will be rounded up for maximum total points awarded for admission test scores.

*Student must meet the Reading score of 70 and the Math score of 65 to move to the selective point system process
