3. Reports

3.1 President's Report

- The groundbreaking ceremony for the Technology Education Complex will take place on February 25, 2026, at 3:00 p.m. Construction begins in Spring 2026 and is anticipated to be completed in Spring 2027
- The Board of Trustees approved the college to move forward with identifying additional funds needed for the North Campus Automotive Building project, increasing the project's budget from 27,500 to \$35,000,000. 12-month architectural design phase, with a construction phase of an additional 12 months.
- The college will be moving from Blackboard to Canvas as its Learning Management System (LMS). This change aligns the learning platform with the NC K-12 system and with the majority of NC Public Universities. Rowan-Cabarrus will launch a limited set of courses in the Canvas Platform this summer (2026).
- Academic and student engagement committee approved minor revisions to the Work-based Learning Policy, and heard updates on the college's enrollment growth, and the LMS.
- The N105 Auditorium opened in January 2026 renovations costed \$2,108,256
- The Driving training range project cost \$9,761,000 and begins construction in Spring 2026, and anticipates completion in Spring 2027
- South campus HVAC improvements have begun in January and will be completed in Summer 2026
